

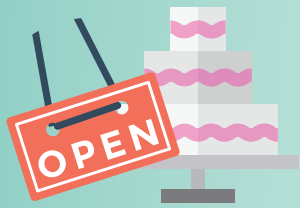

"Sweet Cakes" provides cake to customer in a same-sex relationship for her mother's wedding.



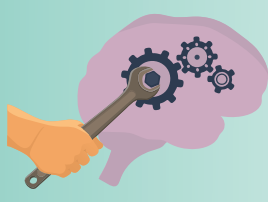
January 2013

"Sweet Cakes" declines request for custom-designed cake for same-sex wedding, citing religious beliefs.



August 2013

Couple files complaint with Oregon Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI).



August 2013

During an interview about the Kleins, BOLI Commissioner Brad Avakian states, "The goal is to rehabilitate."



September 2013

"Sweet Cakes" storefront closed after boycotts, threats, picketing.



July 2015

BOLI penalizes Kleins \$135,000. Orders them to stop expressing their views.



February 2016

First Liberty agrees to represent Kleins and engages former White House Counsel Boyden Gray as volunteer attorney.



March 2017

Oral arguments in Oregon Court of Appeals
