ORDER

For the reasons stated in the foregoing Memorandum Opinion, it is this 30th day of November, 2015, by the United States District Court for the District of Maryland, ORDERED that:

1. The motion for summary judgment filed by Plaintiffs American Humanist Association, et al. (ECF No. 80) BE, and the same hereby IS, DENIED;

2. The motions for summary judgment filed by Defendants The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (ECF No. 86) and Intervenor-Defendants The American Legion, et al. (ECF No. 83) BE and the same hereby ARE, GRANTED;

3. The motions for leave to file memoranda of *amici curiae* (ECF Nos. 94; 95; 96) BE, and the same hereby ARE, DENIED;

4. It is HEREBY DECLARED that the ownership, maintenance and display of the Monument by the Commission do not violate the

Establishment Clause of the First Amendment to the United States Constitution;

5. Judgment BE, and the same hereby IS, ENTERED against Plaintiffs and in favor of Defendants; and

6. The clerk will transmit copies of the Memorandum Opinion and this Order to counsel for the parties and CLOSE this case.
