Statement Regarding Lawsuit Against Judge Wayne Mack

Montgomery County, TX— An anti-religion activist group filed a lawsuit against First Liberty Institute client, Judge Wayne Mack, a Justice of the Peace, because he allows chaplains from various faith groups to offer invocations at the start of his court sessions.

"The FFRF continues to harass Judge Mack despite repeatedly losing in court," said Hiram Sasser, General Counsel to First Liberty. "It's ridiculous that a group from Wisconsin would continue to fight invocations similar to those the Supreme Court of the United States has twice ruled are constitutional. Judge Mack already defeated the FFRF once. We look forward to defending Judge Mack and helping him win yet again in the face of this blatant harassment."
